Abstract: The conflict over Palestine started at the beginning of the 19th century when the colonizing powers decided to establish a foreign body in the Arab and Islamic World. The Jews were nominated for this purpose in order to get rid of them, to deport them from Europe and to control the Arab and Islamic region. The migration to Palestine started on the basis of “a Land without people for people without Land”, as propagated by the Zionist Movement. This migration changed the population body in Palestine. For instance, pre- 1918, the Jewish people were less than 8%; however, they have become 52.5% while the Arabs have become 47.5%. in addition to reasons related to the high birth rate culture and Islamic resistance, this change is attributed to the religious conflict and the determination of the Palestinians to kick the occupation out of their land.
